

CT EXAMINATION OF THE BRAIN:

Spiral CT scans of the brain were obtained. Scans were obtained parallel to the orbital meatal line. Intravenous contrast was not utilized in the exam. The patient was imaged with brain windows.

The posterior fossa and sella turcica are unremarkable. The brainstem appears intact. Ventricular system, basal cisterns, subarachnoid spaces and sylvian fissures appear normal.

Supratentorially, there is no evidence of hemorrhage or focal mass lesion. No intraaxial or extraaxial collections are noted. No midline shift is apparent. The calvarium appears intact.

Limited views of the orbits and paranasal sinuses appear normal.

IMPRESSION:

Normal non-contrast CT scan of the head.

No any obvious intracranial abnormality is detected.
