

STUDY: SKULL X-RAY, 4 VIEWS

HISTORY:

TECHNIQUE: Four views of the skull are submitted for interpretation.

COMPARISON: None.

FINDINGS:

The bones of the vault of the skull show normal alignment and normal architecture.

No focal bone lesion is seen.

There is no evidence of any obvious fracture.

The clinoid processes appear intact.

The pituitary fossa appears normal.

No abnormal intracranial calcification is seen.

The petrous apices and internal auditory meati as seen through the orbit appear normal.

The atlanto-axial junction appears normal.

The sutures and vascular markings appear normal.

No soft-tissue abnormality is seen.

IMPRESSION:

No any obvious acute abnormality is detected.
