STUDY: LUMBAR SPINE X-RAY, 4 VIEWS.
HISTORY:
TECHNIQUE: Anteroposterior, Lateral, Right Oblique and Left Oblique views of the lumbar spine are submitted for interpretation.
COMPARISON: None.
FINDINGS:
The vertebrae shows normal alignment.
The lumbar lordosis is well maintained.
The vertebral bodies show no abnormality.
The intervertebral disc spaces are normal at all the levels.
No evidence of osteophytes is noted.
The pedicles, laminae, transverse as well as spinous processes are normal.
There is no evidence of any obvious fracture or any focal bone lesion.
No abnormal soft tissue calcification is seen.
Both sacro-iliac joints appear unremarkable.
IMPRESSION:
Normal lumbar spine exam.
