

STUDY: RIGHT KNEE X-RAY, 4 VIEWS.

HISTORY:

TECHNIQUE: Anteroposterior, Lateral, Oblique and intercondylar notch views of the right knee are submitted for interpretation.

COMPARISON: None.

FINDINGS:

The bones of the right knee show normal alignment.

The bones show normal architecture.

The articular margins and joint space of various joints appear normal.

There is no evidence of any obvious fracture or any focal bone lesion.

There is no abnormal periosteal reaction.

There is no radiological evidence of any joint effusion or loose bodies.

There is no evidence of any osteomyelitis or sequestrum.

No soft tissue calcification is seen.

IMPRESSION:

No any obvious acute abnormality is detected.
